Beginner = Horsemanship, riding basics, walk, trot & work over poles

Limit = Horsemanship, W/T/ Poles, basic x-rail work, + learning to canter

Novice = Horsemanship, W/T/C, pole & jumping approx 1'

Intermediate = Horsemanship, W/T/C pole & jumping approx 2'6"

Advanced = Horsemanship, more advanced flat work, pole & jumping
approx to 3'
